## Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Wacton (STRO13387) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to urgent carriageway and verge repair works the use by vehicles (of any class) of the U76030 Market Lane from its junction with U76030 Hall Lane for 830m south westwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Wacton will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: Frosts Lane, Frith Way High Green, Woodrow Lane, Station Road, Moulton Road, B1334 Station Road A140 Ipswich Road, A140 Long Stratton Bypass, A140 Norwich Road A140 The Street, Flowerpot Lane, Stratton Road, Hall Lane (Pulham Market, Great Moulton, Tivetshall, Wacton, Long Stratton, Tharston and Hapton, Aslacton).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

The closure/restriction is necessary or expedient because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025.

This Notice shall be in effect from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025 or until the closure/restriction no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
