Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (STRO13230) affecting the A146 Loddon Road / Trowse Bypass from its junction with B1332 Bungay Road to its junction with A146 Barrett Road ("Road A") and A146 Loddon Road / Trowse Bypass from its junction with A146 Martineau Lane to its junction with C577 Kirby Lane ("Road B") in the Parish of Trowse with Newton to facilitate lining works, the Roads A and B will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 21:00 and 06:00 from 26th August to 7th September 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 19th October 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: B1332 Bungay Road, Norwich Road, The Street, Bungay Road, Norwich Road, B1527 Church Road, Short New Road, Hempnall Road, Mill Road, A140 Ipswich Road, Norwich Road A146 Lakenham Road, Hall Road, Barrett Road (Poringland, Swainsthorpe, Kirstead, Framingham Earl, Brooke, Morningthorpe and Fritton, Topcroft, Keswick and Intwood, Stoke Holy Cross, Woodton, Hempnall, Tasburgh, Saxlingham Nethergate, Long Stratton, Caistor St. Edmund and Bixley, Newton Flotman).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 19th October 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
