

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (STRO14226) affecting the A140 Norwich Road from its junction with the B1527 Hempnall Road Roundabout to its junction with A140 Long Stratton Bypass (the "Road") in the Town of Long Stratton to facilitate carriageway resurfacing, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 20:00 and 06:00 from 18<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 4<sup>th</sup> July 2026 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: A140 Ipswich Road / Norwich Road / Ipswich Road, A47 Trunk Road, A146 Loddon Road/ Norwich Road/ Loddon Bypass/ Beccles Road/ Norwich Road, A143 Yarmouth Road/ Kirby Cane Bypass/ Broome Bypass/ Bungay Road/ Old Railway Road/ Bungay Road/ Harleston Bypass/ Brockdish/Needham Bypass/ Scole Road/ Bungay Road/ Lower Street/ Bungay Road/ Scole Stuston Bypass, A140 Scole Bypass/ Dickleburgh Bypass/ Ipswich Road/ Long Stratton Bypass (Brome and Oakley, Stockton, Framingham Pigot, Brockdish, Pulham Market, Swainsthorpe, Redenhall with Harleston, Bungay, Earsham, Ellingham, Ditchingham, Stuston, Chedgrave, Trowse with Newton, Kirby Bedon, Denton, Dickleburgh and Rushall, Yelverton, Keswick and Intwood, Broome, Stoke Holy Cross, Needham, Hellington, Hales, Scole, Tivetshall, Wacton, Gillingham, Tasburgh, Saxlingham Nethergate, Ashby St. Mary, Loddon, Long Stratton, Sisland, Thurton, Caistor St. Edmund and Bixley, Wortwell, Kirby Cane, Alburgh, Burston and Shimpling, Holverston, Newton Flotman).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 4<sup>th</sup> July 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

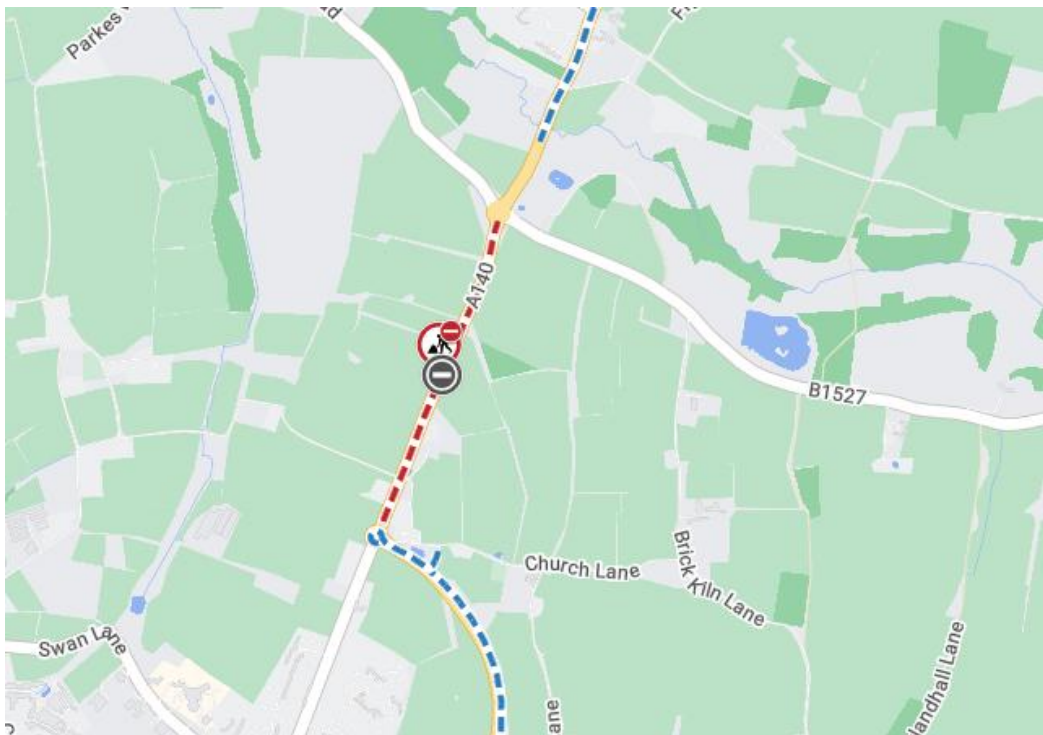
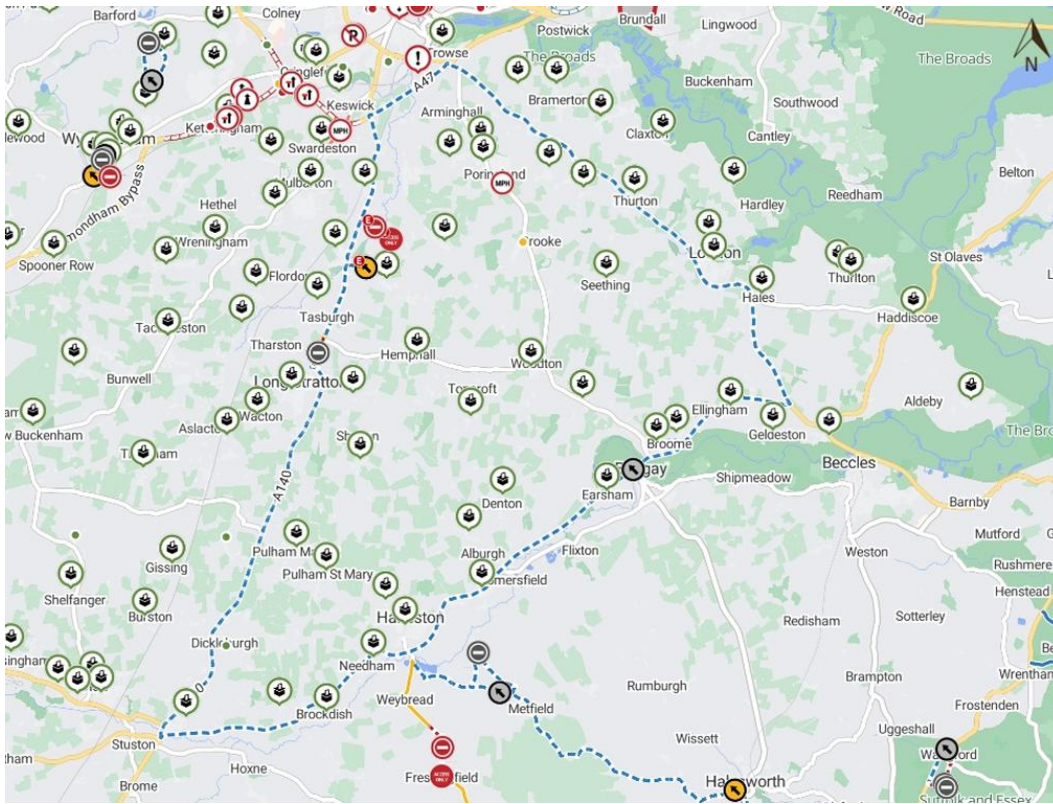
