## Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Long Stratton (STRO13269) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to safety reasons in connection with works to build Long Stratton Bypass the use by vehicles (of any class) of the U76124 Brands Lane from its junction with A140 Norwich Road to its junction with U76028 Picton Road (the "Road") in the Town of Long Stratton will be temporarily subject to a one-way restriction (westbound) allowing traffic to only travel westbound.

Alternative route is via: N/A

The works promoter for this restriction is: Norfolk County Council.

The restriction is necessary or expedient because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

The restriction is anticipated to take place from 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> August 2025 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 5<sup>th</sup> August 2025 where the restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall be in effect from 1<sup>st</sup> August to 5<sup>th</sup> August 2025 or until the restriction no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 5<sup>th</sup> August 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.


A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
