Norfolk County Council (Long Stratton, Remembrance Parade) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 – Notice Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("RTRA 1984") as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994

Norfolk County Council, hereby give notice that to facilitate the Remembrance Parade, they intend to make an Order under Section 16A of the RTRA 1984 and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict/prohibit vehicular traffic on the:

- a. **Ipswich Road** from its junction with C500 Flowerpot Lane to its junction with C355 Hall Lane; and
- b. **C500 Flowerpot Lane** from its junction with Ipswich Road to its junction with U76574 St Mary's Road

in the Town of Long Stratton.

The Order shall be in effect (in force) on 9th November 2025 or until the restrictions are no longer necessary. The roads will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) for the duration of the Remembrance Parade which is anticipated to be between 10:50 and 11:20. The restrictions specified will only have effect at such times and to such extent as indicated by the display of on-site signs.

Alternative route will be via: C500 Flowerpot Lane, U76249 Manor Road, C345 Swan Lane, The Street.

The promoter of the event is Long Stratton Town Council.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of, a restriction or prohibition imposed by this Order shall be guilty of an offence.
