Urgent Notice
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Long Stratton (STRO14678) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to urgent removal of overhead lines and poles the use by vehicles (of any class) of the **C355 Mill Road** from its junction with U76180 Parkers Lane for 90 metres south-eastwards (“Road A”) and **U76132 Mill Lane** from its junction with C355 Mill Road for 300 metres northwards (“Road B”) in the Town of Long Stratton will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: **Road A:** Hall Lane, Ipswich Road, A140 Long Stratton Bypass/ Ipswich Road, Stoney Lane, Colegate End Road, Coles Common, Bush Green, Hardwick Road, Ansons Lane, The Green, Mill Road. **Road B:** Edges Lane, School Road, Common Lane, Blacksmiths Lane, Mill Road (Pulham Market, Morningthorpe and Fritton, Shelton and Hardwick, Tivetshall, Wacton, Long Stratton).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: UK Power Networks.

The closure/restriction is necessary or expedient because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Road A and Road B.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place between 09:00 and 17:00 on 22nd May 2026 but the Road A and Road B may continue to be closed/restricted until the 26th May 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall be in effect from 22nd to 26th May 2026 or until the closure/restriction no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 26th May 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.

Any existing restrictions or prohibitions within Orders made under the RTRA 1984 will become suspended where they conflict with the provisions of this Notice during the operation of this Notice.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

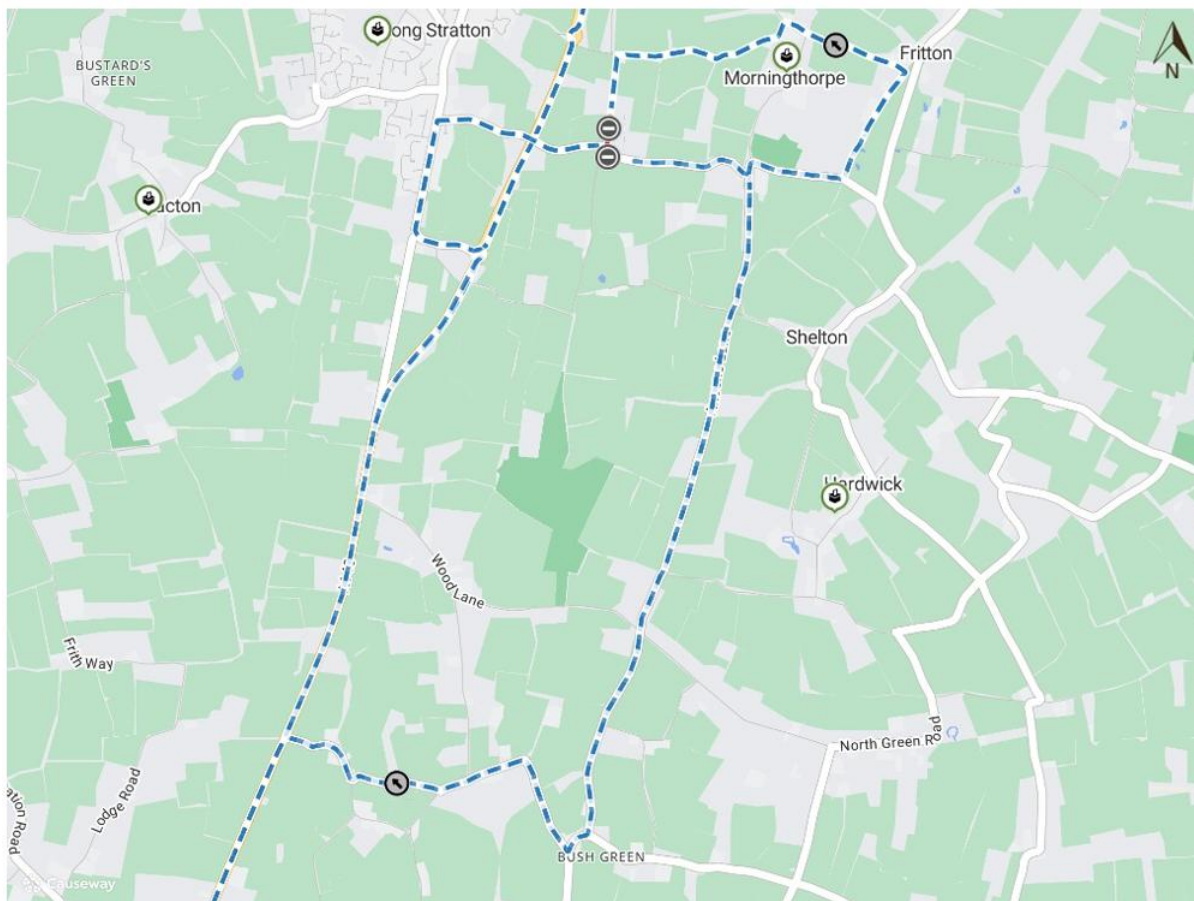
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

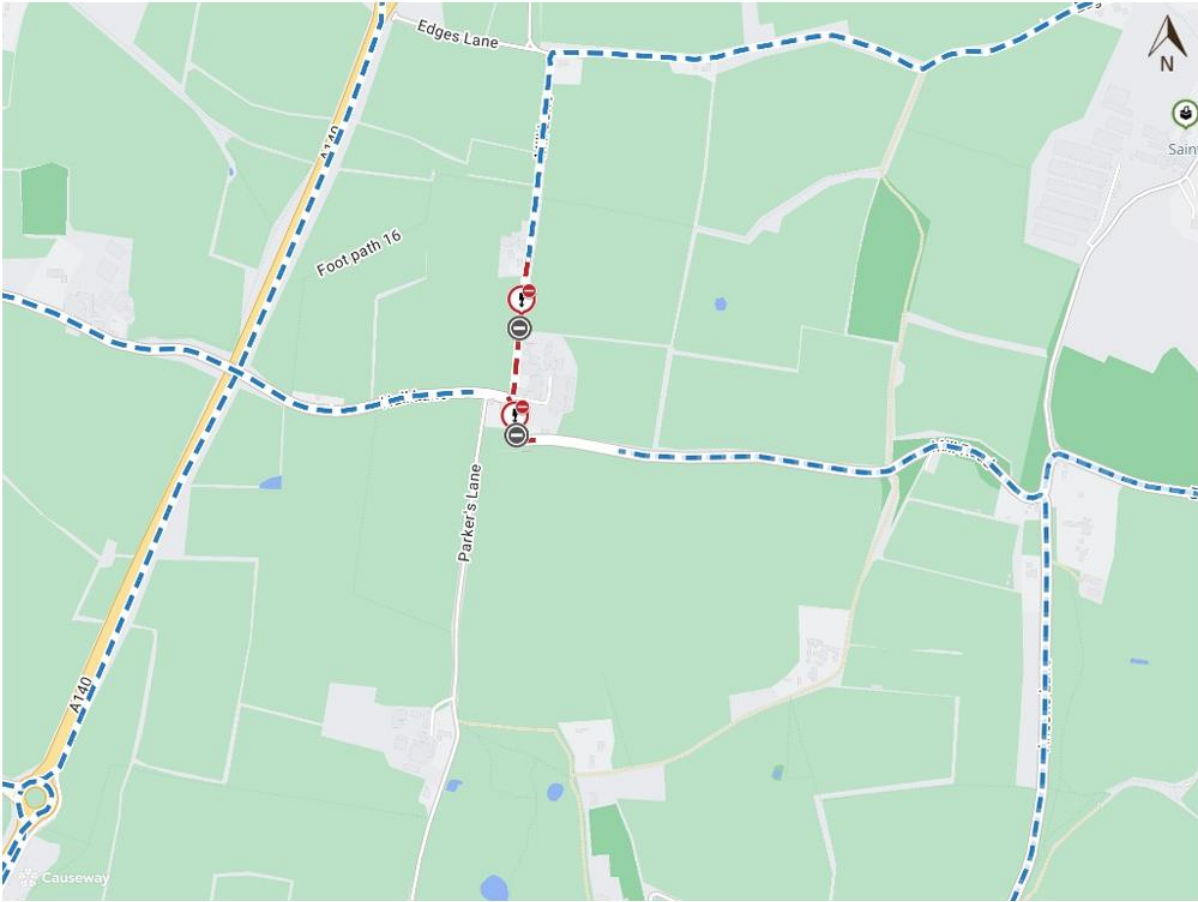
