1. To consider apologies for absence

3. To receive a report from the Groundsman regarding repair work undertaken at the playing fields

The groundsman gave a report regarding the recent repair works that he had undertaken. There are no areas for concern, with the ASB at the Pavilion having ceased.

Councillor Woodham enquired as to what was happening with the corner of the playing field, the Clerk informed the Committee that the work was booked in for 5th July. The contractor advised that they will complete a visual inspection for nests to comply with the legal aspect of it being nesting season. Any nest discovered will be left alone.

The groundsman enquired about having a platform and chipper in order to cut the trees and hedges, the Clerk advised that options will be looked at.

The Clerk advised that with the start of the new street lighting contract she would like the lampposts numbered to make reporting easier. This will be something the groundsman will undertake.

5. To discuss and decide on exploring land ownership of unowned land in Long Stratton.

After a lengthy discussion it was resolved that the Clerk will undertake an ongoing project of finding out who owns pieces of land in Stratton.
