- Respect.

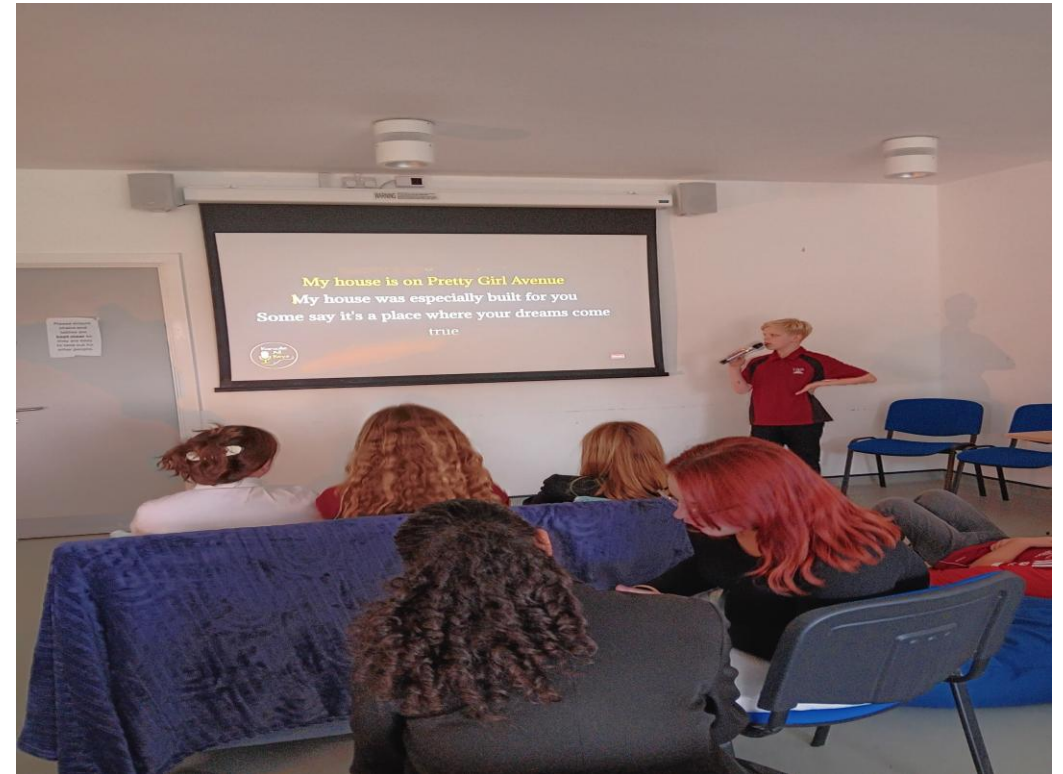
