Christmas Community Event, Road Closure, Saturday 6th December, 12pm - 7pm.

We're delighted to let you know about the upcoming Christmas Community Event, taking place on Saturday 6th December. It promises to be a festive and fun-filled day for all, and we hope you'll be able to join in the celebrations.

To help keep everyone safe and ensure the event runs smoothly, the Town Council has arranged a temporary road closure from the junction of Swan Lane to the Queens Head Public House. This will allow visitors to enjoy the attractions without the risk of passing traffic.

We understand how important it is for residents to access their homes, so we've put measures in place to make this as easy as possible. While the road will be closed to through traffic, controlled access will be maintained for residents, with support from event marshals.

Business Access and Parade Diversion

We also recognise the importance of passing trade to local businesses. The junction of Swan Lane will remain open for most of the day. However, there will be a planned road closure from Flowerpot Lane to Swan Lane between 16:55 and 18:05 (or earlier if the parade finishes sooner) to allow the 'Light-Up' Parade to walk safely from the church to the event area near the Queens Head.

During this time, diversions will be in place via Flowerpot Lane and Manor Road, ensuring continued access to Swan Lane and local businesses.

- Before the event: Contact the Town Council office for any road closure inquiries using the details at the top of this letter.
- On the day (11:00–19:00): Call the event marshals directly on 07563 907744 for help accessing your property. Event marshals will be on hand throughout the day and equipped with radios to assist you.

Thank you for your support in making this a safe and joyful event for the whole community. We look forward to celebrating with you.
