

**Norfolk County Council (Tasburgh)**  
**(Emergency Notice)**  
**Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024**  
**Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)**

Notice (STRO10335)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to flooding at the ford the use by vehicles of the U76001 Low Road from its junction with C497 Bungay Road for 230m northwards in the PARISH OF TASBURGH will be temporarily prohibited from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2024 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 21 days within the period.

This Notice has a maximum duration of 21 days. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Notice, the operational period of this Notice may become extended by issuing an Order or further Notice to allow completion of the works for a maximum duration of 18 months.

Alternative route is via: Low Road, Saxlingham Lane, Grove Lane, Church Road, A140 Ipswich Road, A140 Norwich Road, Bungay Road (Tharston and Hapton, Tasburgh, Long Stratton).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
