

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (STRO13578) affecting the U76022 Fairstead Lane from 520 metres south-east of its junction with U76220 Quaker Lane for 150 metres south-eastwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Hempnall to facilitate pole safety testing works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 09:30 and 15:30 on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 16<sup>th</sup> February 2026 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Fairstead Lane, A140 Ipswich Road, A140 Norwich Road, Hempnall Road, Mill Road, The Street, Broaden Lane (Morningthorpe and Fritton, Hempnall, Tasburgh, Long Stratton)

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Openreach.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 16<sup>th</sup> February 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


**Penalty:** £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
